said W^m Giffen being willing and desirous to sever and bear himself the said George
against and the whole he might sustain by the aforesaid partnership New York
Slavery Settlement W^m 3rd which for and in consideration of the premises as aforesaid for
the further consideration of one dollar to have in hand paid by the said W^m 3rd Slave
the receipt whereof a timely acknowledgment hath granted hereunto will and covenants
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said W^m 3rd Slave
as least for that purpose the following property to wit one bag horse & buggy 3 hens
for cattle and increase and 15 hogs and wherein our best estimate all my farming utensils and
house hold and kitchen furniture upon trust nevertheless that the said W^m 3rd Slave
shall at any time hereafter when being requested by either of the aforesaid parties shall
call the aforesaid property for each of her advertising the time and place of sale and act
of the proceeds of such sale for her own use satisfying all expenses attending the same then
paying the above named W^m 3rd for while the said W^m 3rd is away had the surplus of
any pay are to the said Giffen his best account and the said Giffen hereby
covenants to the said Slave that he is prepared for an absolute for simple right in
the property above mentioned Sett witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and
