Sims and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Bathampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Henry Sims of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Dennis S. Sims and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to him or them paid by the said Henry Sims as or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do make and grant to the said Henry Sims and his wife and heirs the said Henry Sims his heirs and assigns forever all those eight hills and meadows of or unto to me and to my certain trust a part of land and premises situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Bathampton and parish of South Eaton containing by estimation one hundred and thirty acres for the sum of or less it being the condition of land which was bequeathed to the said Dennis S. Sims and his heirs & children by their dear departed Master Henry Simler in his last will and testamant unto almost the said Dennis Sims his heirs and assigns now bounded by the lands of said Henry Sims above estate and thens to have and to hold all the aforesaid eight hills and meadows of land the said Dennis S. Sims and Elizabeth his wife of me and to the above described land referred of land and premises unto me and singular in appurtenance thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto him the said Henry Sims his heirs and assigns forever to me the only person and sole owner of land the said Henry Sims his heirs and assigns forever and the said Dennis S.
