The Deed of Bargain and Sale from Richard of Williams's wife to James of Scotland was proved by the oaths of James Magrath and Jacob Barrow two of the justices thereof and on the 18 day of March 1636 was proved by the oath of Jacob Barrow the other justice thereof and registered with the certificate of the survey examination and acknowledgment of the wife substituted in Record

This Indenture made and returned into the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March one thousand eight hundred and forty five between here James Simon Magrath and S.D. Magrath his wife under the seal and seal of William of Wattle Magrath her of the one part and Edward G. Brampton and Marthe Wattle Brampton his wife of the second part. Whereas it is in consideration of the sum of fifty hundred dollars current Money in hand paid being a part of the sum of one thousand one hundred dollars current by the aforesaid Wattle Magrath to be laid out for land for the benefit and use of the aforesaid Marthe Wattle Brampton they the aforesaid here James Simon Magrath and S.D. Magrath have bargained and sold out by these presents to and unto of their said bargain and sale unto the aforesaid Marthe Wattle Brampton all of that tract of land usually purchased by the said here James Simon Magrath & S.D. Magrath from the before mentioned Edward G. Brampton as will appear by his deed bearing date heretofore eighth day of the month of October containing by estimation two hundred and fifty two acres more or less as is hereunto and appertained by the said Marthe Wattle Brampton so and during her natural life and after her death a part of her children as they be then living and the share of such children as they have and during the lifetime of their mother said above taken why such share as should have fallen to the deceased children had they survived their mother and in the death the said Marthe Wattle Brampton have the children in the share of deceased children their firm and after the death of the said Marthe Wattle Brampton the said tract of land is hereby conveyed unto Amanda Simcock also Brampton wife of Richard Brampton for and during her life and after her death to her children which the boys have at her death and the share of any deceased children as above directed in the case of Marthe Wattle Brampton to have and to hold the said tract of land as above directed to her the said Marthe Wattle Brampton during her life and her children and their issue
