This Indenture made the first day of December in the year of our last now thousand eight hundred fifty six between Joseph S. Garrison of Newmarket County Withles W. Garrison of Southampton County James Garret & Elbert Thompson's Executors his wife of both of which County in the State of Virginia all of the one part, and Both D. Williams of the County of Southampton sheweth of the other part Whereas that he and in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Both D. Williams at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Joseph S. Garrison Withles W. Garrison James Garret & Elbert Thompson's wife as the land and distribution of George W. Garrison late decd have granted bargained and sold and by their presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Both D. Williams his heirs and assigns two certain tracts or parcels of land lying on each side of Rock ~~creek~~^{creek} river and bounded thereby the one lying on the upstream County of Southampton the other in the upstream County of Dale of right and commenced by the upstream river and lying directly opposite each other and containing seven rows three or less and adjoining the lands belonging to the heirs of Daniel Howard ad on the east and Withles By on the west together with all and singular the premises and several ornaments and remainments great and also including specific church and every part and parcel thereof It hath and to woteth the said Both D. Williams that the same tract or parcels of land with the household furniture and all and singular other the premises and appurtenances hereto before mentioned is intended to be bargained and sold with every part and parcel thereof unto my of this eighth hundred and appurtenances unto the said Both D. Williams his heirs and assigns forever it and for the more perfect and entire effect of here the said Both D. Williams his heirs and assigns forever will the said Joseph S. Garrison James Garret Elbert Thompson's wife for themselves and their heirs the said Both D. Williams his heirs and assigns the premises before mentioned unto the said Both D. Williams his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Joseph S. Garrison Withles W. Garrison James Garret & Elbert Thompson's wife or either of them in return of their lands out of all and every other person claiming by thought or under whom shall act and do personally and present depend by their presents It is witness Whereof the said parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the five and sixth above written
