belonging to my late friend Mary Agnes Rogers late widow and living in the County of  
Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid containing 523 acres to be the same land and  
more bounded by the town of East Cowes ~~James~~ <sup>James</sup> Cottrell and - and William Cottrell and that  
Wesley Duley together with all house offices buildings goods pasture orchards and  
waters and other course whatsoever belonging or in any way appertaining to say aforesaid right  
in the land and premises aforesaid to have the said Wesley Duley to have and to his heirs forever  
and I the said Charlotte Brown for myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns do  
give these presents witness and grant to and unto the said Wesley Duley his heirs and assigns  
that el. the said Charlotte Brown will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the rights  
title claim or demands of any person or persons claiming a dower in the said or any part of my  
right and title to the lands etc aforesaid above the said Charlotte Brown hath hereto set her  
hand and affixed her seal the day and date above written
