Pittman & others of the said County with other property in certain lands & parcels of land lying in the County aforesaid for the purpose of securing the payment of two hundred and one dollar and seven cents due to Josiah Pittman also one hundred and twenty six dollars and eighty two cents due to Pittman Pittman & others by the sum of which I am authorized and at my expense do sent James E. Draker and William E. Pittman trustee and such James E. Draker info for me and account have sold fifty one and one fourth acre of one of the lots of land aforesaid in the debt of Josiah aforesaid to Russell Barrett of the said County the boundaries of which will appear on the debt following for the sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars and thirty one and one fourth acre of land property of the 4th lot to and Pittman Pittman the receipt of which we Pittman & Pittman having acknowledged and to acknowledge I part Pittman caused the undersigned of the last sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars and thirty one and one fourth acre of land property of the said James E. Pittman trustee as aforesaid to Josiah Pittman Pittman in consideration of the said James E.
