Edwards at any time hereafter upon my request by either of the aforesaid parties to make sale of the property above mentioned after advertising the same and place thereof out of the premises of and date shall pass and delivery all costs attending the same, three per cent and entry charged for which the said Gentry & Edwards stand bound as security - and the balance of my money over to the said Edward S. Turner who will take testimony above of the parties hereunto at their hands, sealed the day and year above written.
