partner of the other party Whipple that the said Thomas Draper of or and is considerable of
the sum of fifty Dollars Darmers money to have in hand paid by the said Willard Whipple
the receipt whereof a book acknowledged hath granted beginning told and confirmed and by
these presents doth grant, bargaine and sell unto the said Willard Whipple to him and his
heirs forever all my right in a certain tract or parcel of land formerly belonging to James
Draper contained by estimation fifty six and 1/2 acres in the town of Easton aforesaid and
bounded as follows to wit, beginning at a spruce tree in Ridge Brookfield and Patrick
River line stands along said Brookfield line to a black pine or corner tree in Ridge Brookfield
Line stands and the head of Garverick Brookfield stands alone along said Brookfield line
and the 2 ends to a pond a corner tree in the said land and the said Brookfield to a pond
call "Pond" the head of a brook that flows down the bank to the fish of tomoko stream upsets
the said bounds bearing said land and Patrick River three stone markers were along said
River line to the first station together with all my rights to the said tract of land and premises
