This Indenture made the tenth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred
 and forty five between John Samplings, Clerk of the Peace and Sheriff of
 Southampton County, Virginia of the one part, Whereas, that the said John
 Samplings is constituted of the said Sheriff of the Commonwealth to have in hand paid
 by the said Sarah Peppers at or before the meeting and delivery of these presents the
 receipt, whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents to bargain
 and sell unto the said Thomas Peppers his heirs and assigns one half of a certain tract, a
 parcel of land containing twenty seven acres and a half belonging to the heirs of John Samplings
 deceased and bounded as follows by John Samplings as the southwest side and by the
 said Sarah Peppers as the north side, side next to the said John Samplings' heirs together
 with all and the revenues and revenues and revenues and revenues growing and due unto
 upon and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. It hath well to hold
 the said tract a parcel of land with the tenements builded thereon and all and singular things
 the premises heretofore mentioned and intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel
