whereof he hereby acknowledges he has granted, bargained and sold and by these presents
do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Bentley D. Butler his heirs and assigns
forever as certain lands, a parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid town
of Southwickfield and parish of Saint John Easton, over hundred and fifty acres
to the same more or less, and bounded by the lands of said Bentley D. Butler being
Brooks said John Marquay and others his heirs the lands or parcels of lands which
William R. Whitfield enjoyed as a half of said farm date on the 7th day of January
1844 to Thomas B. Morell as trustee for the benefit of Helen M. Estey and others and
which said land was sold by said Thomas B. Morell under the seal of record aforesaid
on the 17th day of October 1845 and the said John Marquay became the purchaser
of the said Harry Whitfield's interest of the said William R. Whitfield not having enjoyed
the right of Dwre in said land in the seal of record aforesaid who hereby conveys the
same or any part thereof with said John Marquay to said Bentley D. Butler for the consideration
aforesaid. So he will to hold the above described lands or parcels of land and premises
with all and singular its appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining and
have the said Bentley D. Butler his heirs and assigns forever to use for the sole profit
and benefit of him the said Bentley D. Butler his heirs and assigns forever and the
said John Marquay and Harry Whitfield for themselves their heirs executors and administrators
at each of said debts hereby convenant and agree to and with the said Bentley D. Butler to
pay him such debts and expenses and attorney fees that they will by their several instruments and from time
to time execute and give to him the aforesaid lands or parcels of land and premises and
any part or parcel thereof, upon the claim or demands of all and every other person or persons
whatsoever that may be entitled thereto the last said Marquay and Harry Whitfield have executed
their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
