This 25th instant and entered into this 25th day of April in the year 1824 before
Robert Shelly of the first party William Womack of the second party and Henry S. Ellis of the
third party all of the County of Norfolk and State of Virginia Westerville that wherein
the said Robert Shelly stands fully intitled to the sum of \$1000 on the just and true
sum of one hundred and thirty two dollars due by said Plaintiff to demand the 1st day of August
1823 and being desirous and willing to record the premises wherefore the said J. S. Edwards
the 2^d Plaintiff Shelly for and consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid
by the said William Womack at and before the recording and delivery of these presents
the said Shelly swearing a freely acknowledged basis given payment damages and costs and
setteth by these presents give grant bargained and sold unto the said Womack and his
legal representatives forever the following property to only two feather beds and furniture etc
to the said Shelly household and kitchen furniture of all kinds and of every description
his former usual way of doing business called and known by many under the name of
an "Layman" and the table which she is in good order stock of bags and all other property
of every description to the said Shelly may be intituled to for the use and purpose in
his said Shelly's house and kitchen furniture of all kinds and of every description
against the claim of himself and all other persons answering unto the said William Womack
except the following conditions namely that the said Wm. Womack shall suffer no
loss Shelly to recover no part of the aforesaid property "honestly owing" until the 1st day
of August next or until he may be intituled by Law to sell the same after the 1st
August next and upon such intitulation it shall be lawful for the said Womack to give
him seven days notice of the time and place of sale and tell at the house of L. Shelly or any other
desirable place at his option the property "honestly owing" at public sale for costs and outlays of
the premises arising from such date prior to said 8th day of August after 1st of one thousand
thirty two dollars and all costs attending such sale and if there be then no surplus in
balance as left to the said Womack he shall pay the same to Robert Shelly or to any other
persons intituled by him to receive the same. Also Testimony shew that the parties to this
deed have agreed and doth record the day and year first above written
