His Excellency reads and interprets into the 15th day of April in the year 1838 between
 Regional Chieftay of the first party William Womack of the second party and Saml. Ellis of the
 third party all of the County of Campbell and State of Virginia Whitefield that whereas
 the said Regional Chieftay claims partly indebted to the said Saml. Ellis in the past and for
 sum of one hundred and thirty two dollars and by bond or demand also 1st day of August
 1838 and being desirous not willing to demand the payments thereof until the 1st day of August
 the 2nd Regional Chieftay for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar a bond in hand paid
 by the said William Womack and all before the writing and delivery of these presents
 the Recd. whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold unto
 the by these presents yet granted bargained and sold unto the 2nd Regional Chieftay and to his
 legal Representatives heirs the following property to wit two further bonds and firmness
 the 1st Chieftay himself and his heirs and assigns of all kinds and of every description
 his former debts of all kinds and his heirs and assigns of all kinds and of every description
 one day here and the bonds which the 1st party has made the present year
 of every description by the said Chieftay may be indebted to for the sum and papers in
 before stated all of which property the 2nd Regional Chieftay hath forever assigned and
 up the claim of himself and all other persons whatsoever unto the 2nd William Womack
 Upon the following conditions to wit that the said 2nd William Womack shall deliver the 1st
 to Chieftay to remain in possession of the aforesaid property hereby conveyed until the 1st day
 of August next, a writ may be returned by Saml. Ellis to sell the same after the 1st
 day of July and upon such conditions it shall be lawful for the 2nd William Womack to give
 two days notice of the time and place of sale and sell at the house of the 1st Chieftay in any
 suitable place at his place the property hereby conveyed at public sale for cash not only of
 the proceeds arising from bonds sold to Saml. Ellis but all before of the same
 thereby two dollars and all costs attending such sale and if there be then in Campbell
 at least in the 2nd William Womack himself pay the same to Regional Chieftay or if any other
 person authorize by him to receive the same the 2nd Regional Chieftay or the parties aforesaid
 have herein and do hereby and seal the day and year first above written
 signed sealed and delivered in presence of us
