

by indentures of Trust of that date convey to the said W<sup>m</sup> Wright his heirs and assigns the following property to wit a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of Sir Reginald and John Wigham and known as the Common Well plantation and containing ten hundred and one and three quarters of an acre and likewise in land and meadow and otherwise since the execution and delivery of said deed of Trust, the said Mills & Lawrence have fully satisfied and paid to the said Sir W<sup>m</sup> Lawrence the debt thereby incurred about the said W<sup>m</sup> Wright's debt hereby acknowledged Now His Excellency Whitchurch that for the consideration aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Mills & Lawrence at & before the making and delivery of these presents the wraps whereof a hereby acknowledged by the said William W<sup>m</sup> Wright with the assent and approbation of the said Sir W<sup>m</sup> Lawrence granted and the said W<sup>m</sup> Wright have granted assigned and sold several several and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto Sir W<sup>m</sup> Lawrence confirm unto the said Mills & Lawrence all the estate right title interest claim and demand late at Law and equity which the said W<sup>m</sup> Wright has or holds in the property aforesaid do have and to hold the said property in and to be divided to the said Mills & Lawrence his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever and the said W<sup>m</sup> Wright for himself and his heirs his heirs executors administrators and the said Mills & Lawrence his heirs and assigns in a full and ample manner in the said and contained by the said Mills & Lawrence by the deed of Trust above recited do warrant the said to the said Mills & Lawrence against the claim of him the said W<sup>m</sup> Wright his heirs or assigns and all persons claiming by a matter have W<sup>m</sup> Wright whereby the parties to these presents have heretofore in their hands and about the day and year first above written

This Indenture made between into the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1726 between John Bygones Sr of the one part & W<sup>m</sup> Lawrence of the other part & William S Edwards of the third part Whereas the said Edwards is attorney for the said Bygones in four several debts made payable to James W<sup>m</sup> Bygones in the sum of fifty dollars each the first made payable the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1725 the second on the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1726 the third on the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1727 and the fourth on the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1728 and the said Edwards is also the said Bygones Bail in a suit instituted in the County Superior Court of said County for Southampton County in favour of William S Edwards against the said Bygones being willing and desirous to extinguish the said Bygones debt and the said Bygones being willing and desirous to extinguish the said Edwards debt all's way legal charges allowed on account of his service here in as aforesaid have agreed to convey the property hereof by Indenture unto the said Lawrence in Trust for that purpose have therefore the said Bygones as well for Lawrence in Trust for that purpose have therefore the said Bygones as well for Edwards in consideration of the premises as of the sum of one dollar to have in hand
