acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold and do by these presents grant
convey and sell unto William Gardner his heirs and
successors forever tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
afforementioned County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by late survey
there were 80 acre more or less bounded by the lands of the said
William Gardner, Thomas Morris and Robt. Cooke together with all rights, liberties,
privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging and in the above described tract or parcel of land and
promises make the aforesaid Cecilia to pay him the said William Gardner
and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises unto all and
singular its appurtenances which belongs unto him the said William Gardner
his heirs and successors to and for the sole use of his wife Cecilia and her children if he the
said William Gardner his heirs and successors and the said William Dollard and
Cecilia his wife for themselves their heirs successors assigns in lawfully
conveying and agreeing to and with the said William Gardner his heirs successors and
assigns that they will by their presents wherein and former except the
rights and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of lands and premises and
very first a parcel thereof against the claim or demands of all and every person
