for payment whereof the said John Gardner for a witness to record that the subscriber

consideration of the sum of one dollar or least paid by the said William S.
Gardner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Gardner
for the sum aforesaid grant to myself and carry into the said Notchard
& Robert his heirs and assigns all by the last right title and interest
we and to certain property consisting of slaves and all money owing thereof
now in the hands of Daniel R. McDaniel due to the said John Gardner in right of his
wife from Henry Drayton which said property is now the property of Henry
Drayton in the Circuit Superior Court of Law & Equity for the County of Southampton
and cannot be more particularly described and divided with the remainder
