Chapman about 1 month as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & twenty five dollars and fifty cents of lawful money of the Commonwealth

residence next door to this present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
to have received and doth acknowledge and by these presents to Goffin amount  
into the sum above written his heirs and assigns the following parts of land lying
