and forty six between J. S. Mahood and his wife of the one part and Edward

of the sum of One hundred and ten dollars to him in hand paid by the said Edward
C. Grampson at & before the making and signing of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged both parties bargain and sell and by these presents
the said J. S. Mahood and all their heirs and assigns unto him the said Edward C.
Grampson his heirs and assigns forever full release full and complete full and
entire in the Town of Newmarket in the County of Grampson and State of Virginia
and having in the place of said town as follows Viz: there of said lots are the
forty eight forty two and fifty eight a further description of the land there to
be made by reference to three several deeds from J. S. Mahood Clerk of Grampson
County dated the 1st day of April 1835 the other two lots are the County of Newmarket
there a further description of the said two lots may be made by reference to a deed from
J. S. Mahood Clerk of Grampson County dated the 25th day of April 1838 and recorded
in the State Office of Grampson County Va. with all containing by witness both
are now by the same two or by together with all right title claim or demand
of or unto the said lots or parts of land and premises with their appurtenances
