have and to enjoy a certain tract of land lying and being at the back
of Easthampton containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres more or less to the
lawn more or less and bounded as follows to wch. beginning at a point at the back
of the farm of Holloman Holloman having up a small branch to a pond he named
Moor's pond about a line of the back line to the road then down the road to the
middle of which branch there lies back branch left of which follow west
about land about the length of a袂t. long about a mile and half broad
and across the road will stand it is bounded by said back branch land as much
