 to make sale of the property above conveyed at public auction to the highest bid
 for cash or upon a reasonable credit after having paid the sum of one thousand
 seven hundred & five dollars and cost of the same arising therefrom
 after paying all costs & expenses attending such debt to the conveyance pay to the
 said Butt the rest aforesaid for him and the interest which may have accrued
 theron and the balance of any pay over to the said Edwards bid nothing
 thereof the parties last named set their hands and affixed their seals this day
 3rd instant of 1789

 the other witness that the said Drury Shattock and Abner her selfe are
 conencted by a bond of twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Anna
 Parker at or before the making and delivery of these presents did except
 thereof a tract of land acknowledged to have belonged and debt and by these presents
 to grant bargaine and sell unto Anna Parker her heirs and assigns a certain
 tract of land in the County of Southampton and state of Virginia and
 bounded by the lands of Elizabethtown, Custer, Lester, Lewis, W. Parker
 and Greenbank & Richard containing ten acre more or less together with all
 the buildings and fixtures and conveniences whatsoever and whatsoever growing
 and other realty open and forth above and every part and parcel thereof
 to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto the aforesaid
 Abner and all and singular other the former heretofore mentioned
 inhabitants and all and singular other the former heretofore mentioned
 inhabitants to get bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof
 with every of their rights minsters and appurtenances to the said Anna
