This 1<sup>st</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six I, John C. Dobbs of the County of Southampton of the one part and John Draht of the County of the County of Southampton of the second part and citizen of the County aforesaid of the said third party Wm. Blacker that whereas the said John Draht being party interested to the said Estate by writing deposited under his hand and seal bearing date August the 12<sup>th</sup> eighteen hundred and forty four in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars whereas for the further insurance and securing the payment of the sum aforesaid it is agreed by the said John Draht as a compensation in money shall be paid to the said William Blacker for the benefit of the said Estate for one thousand dollars and no cents more or less to be punctually paid unto him from time thereafter Wm. Blacker that the said William Blacker for and into consideration of the sum aforesaid and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him paid the receipt a yearly acknowledgement shall be given and shall remain unbroken and confirmed by due process of law for himself his heirs executors and administrators grantee and donee here over and confirm unto the said William Blacker all of my rights of said estate called green pasture and swamp for head of hogs and hens the aforesaid William Blacker to have and to keep in trust, property and place to myself present that of this said Estate he shall receive above ten dollars shall punctually pay or cause to be paid to the said William Blacker to be deposited the general sum of one hundred & fifty dollars agreeable to the terms of the said agreement that the said William Blacker shall receive payment and legal release for the property hereby conveyed shall be the regards of the said Estate at any time after the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1846 after giving due notice to the said William Blacker to have and to keep in trust, property the aforesaid pasture land bounded by these bounds and sets the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
