Quintessence of the one part & W^m B. Whitlock of the other part, Witnesseth that the said

to Robert Quincy & Rebecca Quincy his wife in consideration of the sum of Twenty

W^m B. Whitlock five hundred dollars lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by

the said W^m B. Whitlock at & before the making & delivery of these presents

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained & sold & by these

presents to each of them their bargain & sell unto the said W^m B. Whitlock two

hires & apiece, a certain parcel of land and tract lying & being in the County of

Essex adjoining the lands of Col. H. Prince on the West side & bounded by

Indians river on the South & on all other sides by the lands of John W. Whitlock

& containing four hundred & forty six acres more or less the whole tract lies apart on

the County of Gloucester & the other part on the County of Southampton containing one

hundred & twenty six acres more or less adjoining the lands of Matthew Miller on the

West & North side on the South & West the lands of Col. H. Prince on the East & West

& to hold the said lands a parcel of lands with the tenements & improvements & all and

singular also the premises heretofore tenements or improvements to be bargained & sold every

part & parcel thereof with every of their rights tenements & appurtenances unto the said

W^m B. Whitlock his heirs & assigns forever to and for the only proper use & behoof

of him the said W^m B. Whitlock his heirs & assigns forever and the said Robert

Quincy & Rebecca Quincy his wife for themselves & their heirs the said lands or

parcel of lands with all or singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned

unto the said W^m B. Whitlock his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of

them the said Robert Quincy & Rebecca Quincy his wife or either of them their heirs

of their heirs & of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and do demand

& forever depart by their presents and W^m B. Whitlock whereby the said Robert Quincy &

Rebecca Quincy his wife have granted out their lands & tenements the day & year
