This Indenture made this 10 day of October one thousand eight hundred and
forty six between Henry Bailey and Mary his wife of the one part and George
Hart of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to him
paid paid aforesaid sum to me first before the drawing and delivery of this
present the aforesaid Henry aforesaid acknowledged all along the said Henry Bailey
and Mary his wife have granted bargained and sold unto me their present grant,
Lease and release and confirmed unto the said George Hart and to his heirs
and assigns forever all our right title and claim in the tract of land aforesaid
described as follows the further of the said Henry Bailey and his wife and
of said tract a parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton
and adjoining the lands of Mrs. Elizim Thomas Pleasant Drury S. Drury and the
lands belonging to the estate of George B. Holloman A.D. and being situated on each
side of the River road said tract or parcel of land containing by estimation
one hundred acres & the same more or less 30 feet wide to 80 ft the width varying
in the said tract a parcel of land to the said George Hart and to his heirs and
assigns in due proportion and taking forever into the said Henry Bailey and
Mary his wife to further warrant to and with the said George Hart that the
present grant of bargain and sell shall be made from the said George Hart just
to his heirs and assigns forever a good and sufficient warranty against the claim
of whom ever and Henry Bailey and Mary his wife and also against whom ever
and assigns as well as against the right title claim and demand of all manner
other present or persons claiming by descent or under him George Hart himself
the said Henry Bailey and Mary his wife have made out these hands and
sealed the day and date first above written
