Supper of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and unto the said Peter Supper and his wife Mary Steel for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to stand on hand paid by the said John B. Supper at or before the recording and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Peter Supper and his wife Mary Steel his grandchild Supper and held valid by them presents such grant language and will unto the said John B. Supper his heirs and assigns all of our rights and interests in or tract of Land in which David Braine did liege and possessed it being situated in the town of Saint Paul and derived from said David Braine died by the said Peter Supper and his wife Mary Steel will concerning the limits of the said John B. Supper's Heirs Lands, and others and by the Stock water river it being my death part of the above named tract of land with all and singular the cessions and successive remonstrances and other rights, uses and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof as hereunto and to hold all of our right and interest in said tract of land with the cessions and hereditaments unto all and singular other the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John B. Supper his heirs and assigns and all and every other person or persons wheresover the said Peter Supper and his wife Mary Steel their heirs and assigns shall will and do by their presents former warrants and against the right and title unto the said John B.
