one thousand eight hundred forty six between William Sayer of the
first part Rector of the second part and other & thoughts of
the third part all of the County of Southampton State of Virgins wherein
she had William Sayer a servt intituled unto the said Edward Knight
in the sum of Five hundred & fifty two dollars & fifty and due 17 day
of December 1545 also the sum of fifty one dollars due the 2d of Jan
1546 made payable to Sparks Executor of Rector also one hund
and forty & Cents odd demands 1st day of January 1546 for fifty
five dollars also the said William Sayer being willing and desirous
to renew the aforesaid debt and interest Now this Sixteenth Day
writte that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further
consideration of the premises sum of one dollar to have on hand paid
by the said William Sayer by the said Rector & Bishop at and before
the recording and delivery of this present the Rector entituled to have
acknowledged her the said William Sayer hath granted bargained
sold and made over and by these presents doth give grant bargain
and sell and make over and the said Rector & Bishop to have and enjoy
for ever the following property to wit the tract of Land lying long
in the County and State aforesaid containing certaine eight hundred
and fifty acres there being bounded by the Lands of Rector & Bishop
John & Robert Tracy and others by interest in estate of Robert
Perry and other persons nameable the intertions of Abbot & Heding
one hundred more and he further increased eight bush of cattle then future
increaseth thirty bush of hogs then future increased further bush of sheep
& future increased thirty five bushels of corn then thousand pounds of
Wools flocks four flocks both two hils six chace one chace four pecks
one and all other house hold & kitchen furnished to self and one old of the
farming & plantation whiche our cost valable and all other properly belong
to the said Mr. Sayer otherwise called to Rector to his the said Rector &
Bishop to have and behove uppon trust therewith that the said Rector
& Bishop shall at request of either of the aforesaid parties before going at
least ten dayes of the time next p[re]ce of estate shall make written all
the property of service or so much thereof as will be sufficient to satisfy
the aforesaid debts interest and cost and out of the proceeds thereof first
pay to the aforesaid Sayer pay the aforesaid debts uppon her the same due
to Hugh George & Cope & then the balance of any pay as to the same
to them Sayer to her legal Representat[or] and the said Thomas Sayer concur
with the said Rector & Bishop that he is a sufficient man to take for example
right as all the partye fully engag'd and that he will enricht upon
the same against the claim himself and all other persones what
