

This Indenture made the 16th day of Jan^y A.D. one thousand eight hundred and forty seven between James Barrett and his wife Matilda Barrett of Southampton County 2^d of the one part, and Walter Myrick of Stafford County 2^d of the other part, Witnesseth that the said James Barrett and wife Matilda Barrett for and in consideration of the sum of fifty five dollars to them the said James Barrett in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Walter Myrick his heirs and assigns all those and in the above lands of late Mathew Mary Barrett Widow of Jacob Barrett and in being his the said James Barretts undivided interest in the land which will accrue to the estate of the said Matilda Barrett and in her part of the above lands of said Mary Barrett at her the said Mary Barrets also all profits advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said James or his heirs and assigns part of the interest or part of the said Matilda Barrett and in the above lands of said Mary Barrett belonging or in any way appurtenant and the division and divisions remainder and remainders sole issue and profits of the said premises and every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of them the said James Barrett and his wife Matilda Barrett of and to the said James or his heirs and assigns part of the land of the estate of said Matilda Barrett and premises and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said undivided eighth part of the undivided sixth or part of the lands of the above of said Mary Barrett which will accrue to the said Matilda Barrett and all and singular other the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Walter Myrick his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Walter his heirs and assigns forever after the said James Barrett and wife Matilda Barrett for themselves and their heirs the said James and premises and every part and parcel thereof against them and their heirs and assigns all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said Walter Myrick his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by their persons or by their attorneys whom the said James Barrett and his wife Matilda Barrett have named set their hands and affixed their seals in the presence of
