Whitehead the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted Bargained and  
sold and by these presents do grants Bargains and sell unto the said William H  
Everett his heirs and assigns a tract of land containing 1/2 acre to him  
it the sum more or less and known as the land which consisted from Catherine  
Whitehead and to the said William H Whitehead to have and to hold unto the  
said William M Everett his heirs and assigns forever the same bounded tract or parcel  
of land free from the claims or demands of him the said William H Whitehead and  
of all other persons whatsoever witness whereof the parties herein have
