testament of the said Nathaniel Jones, &c sold at public auction to the highest bidder
out of credit of Nine Months a certain tract or parcel of land which the said Nathaniel
Jones died seized and possessed whereby the said Elbridge & Mayot became the
purchaser and by these presents the said Nathan H. Thomas, Executor affiant do bargain
and sell unto the said Elbridge & Mayot his heirs and assigns a certain tract or
parcel of Land containing by estimation Four hundred and Ninety seven acres to
the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid on the North side of
Merrimac River and bounded as follows by the Land of the Whitbread
Campbell & Russel Richard B. Wright and also 30 hours and to hold the said
Four hundred and Ninety seven acres of Land with all and singular the appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Nathaniel Jones and
his heirs or assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Elbridge &
Mayot his heirs and assigns forever and the said Nathan H. Thomas, Executor affiant
doth for himself & executors and the heirs of the said Nathaniel Jones doth further
covenant and agree with the said Elbridge & Mayot his heirs and assigns that the
said Nathan H. Thomas, Executor affiant shall and will warrant and forever defend
the above mentioned tract or parcel of land and premises unto the said Elbridge &
