This Indenture made the 2^d day of October 1846 between Joseph Parker and Susan S. his wife of the County of Sussex of the one part, and John S. P. Pennington of the County of Southampton of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan S. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said John S. P. Pennington the receipts whereof the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan S. his wife do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold and by their persons do grant bargain and sell unto the said John S. P. Pennington one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing three hundred and fifty three acres in the name there of as is bounded as follows to wit: On the North by the Spring Swamp Tract by the lands of William Ingrieke white east by the lands of Samuel Parkman and others and on the West by the lands of Thomas S. Parker, white. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said John S. P. Pennington his heirs and assigns and also all the right title and interest whatever of them the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan S. his wife in and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises to the proper use and behoof of him the said John S. P. Pennington his heirs and assigns forever and the said Joseph H. Parker and Susan S. his wife for themselves and their heirs against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons will or shall and by their persons forever defend.
