Whereas it appears from the Report of Commissioner Cobb made to Southampton
August, Court, 1835 of the account of Peter Edwards administrator on the estate of
Benjamin Edwards that the sum of two thousand four hundred & fifty three dollars
less costs with interest, from the 31st day of December 1835 is due the said Peter
Edwards the Administrator and whereas the said Peter Edwards has agreed to release
the estate of the said Benjamin Edwards from the payment of the aforesaid sum
of Money & interest, or any part thereof upon condition that Garrison R.
Pope and Virginia his wife the daughter and only distributor shall at law of the
said Benjamin Edwards will stand to and abide by the said settlement and will
not require a Settlement, or any other or additional Settlement, of the said Peter
Edwards administration on Benjamin Edwards estate and will release remuneration and
discharge the said Peter Edwards & his securities from any and all responsibility what
ever in relation to the said Peter Edwards transactions on said estate which the said
Garrison R Pope for himself and wife hereby agrees to do. Now therefore in
consideration of the premises the said Peter Edwards does hereby release remuneration
agreed, & discharged the estate of the said Benjamin Edwards from the payment of
the aforesaid sum of two thousand four hundred & fifty three dollars less costs
with interest, from 31st December 1835 as aforesaid or any part thereof until
the said Garrison R Pope for himself and wife hereby binds himself to stand to and
abide by the settlement, above referred to returned to August, court, 1835 and
that, he will, Not disturb the settlement, aforesaid of Peter Edwards administration
on Benjamin Edwards estate for any & Settlement, though or any other or
additional Settlement, of said estate but that, the settlement, aforesaid made shall
be final and that, the said Peter Edwards and his securities for and as
hereby released remunerated and discharged from any and all responsibility whatever
in relation to said Peter Edwards administration on the said Benjamin Edwards which
the testimony whereof the said Peter Edwards & Garrison R Pope have wrote at
their hands & sealed this 18th day of January 1847
