This Indenture made between this 25th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six between Samso Drury of the one part, and Maribah J. Simmons of the other part, Whereas at Marriage is thereby intended to be had and consummated by the permission of God by and between the said Samso Drury and Maribah J. Simmons and Whereas it has been agreed that the said Maribah J. Simmons should after the intended Marriage had receive and enjoy for her own separate use and benefit as well any estate whether real or personal which she may now be entitled to as well as any which she may hereafter acquire by descent gift or devise from her relations and which may be at her sole disposal notwithstanding the coverture and Whereas it has also been agreed that in case the said Maribah J. Simmons should after the said intended Marriage had happen to survive the said Samso Drury that she should not have or claim any part of the real or personal estate whosoever the said Samso Drury should be seized or possessed or entitled unto at any time during the coverture between them by virtue of her dower or title of dower either at common Law or by Statute or by virtue of the Laws of descent and distribution or by virtue of her being entitled to administration of the goods and chattels rights and credits of the said Samso Drury or in any way whatever Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and before written agreements for the said Samso Drury doth hereby covenant and agree that he will not claim or exercise any control over any estate which the said Maribah J. Simmons may now or be entitled to or which she may hereafter acquire but the same shall be as fully under the control and Management and disposal of the said Maribah after the said intended Marriage with the coverture did not exist and the said Maribah J. Simmons hereby covenants to and with the said Samso Drury his heirs and assigns and doth hereby relinquish and disclaims any right, title or interest of any kind whatever in the estate whether real or personal which the said intended husband Samso Drury may be seized or possessed of or entitled to at any time during the coverture between them and hereby covenants that in case she should survive her said intended husband that she will not have or claim any part of his real or personal estate by virtue of her being dower or right of dower or by virtue of her right of administration or by virtue of the Laws of descent and distribution or in any way whatever All Testimony whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and date first above written
