This instrument made and entered into this 15th day of January in the year of our Lord
1846 between Howell S. Scarborough and Christian S. his wife of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia of the one party, and Gen. C. Walker of the County and State
afforeward of the other party, witnesseth that the said Howell S. Scarborough & C.S.
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty four dollars to them in hand
paid by the said Gen. C. Walker the receipt whereof the said Howell S. Scarborough
& C.S. his wife doth hereby acknowledge and confess back again said bargain
and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Gen.
C. Walker one certain tract or parcel of Land lying being and situated in the County
of Southampton containing five acres by its several more or less and bounded as follows
beginning at a white Oak stump a corner in John McNamee's line from thence down
at branch to a black gum at New Market corner from thence at straight line west to
a pine a corner in said Scarborough's line from thence to a post oak corner in said
Walker's line from thence to a corner in Red Oak line to the beginning at said
white Oak stump to have and to hold possess and enjoy the said tract or parcel
of Land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging to
the only proper use and benefit of him the said Gen. C. Walker to him and his heirs
forever and the said Howell S. Scarborough & C.S. his wife for themselves and their heirs
the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises unto the said Gen. C. Walker his heirs
and assigns forever will warrant and by these presents forever defend the same
whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this day and date above
written
