Witnesseth that the said Elizabeth A. Harrison Widow of Wm. H. Harrison did for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars Current Money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said Merch. S. Davis at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Merch. S. Davis his heirs and assigns all my right like interest and claim in and to the said Land. The reversions and remainders and remainderments yearly and other rents issues and profits of my said husband William H. Harrison which fell to me as and for my dower during my life only lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at the school house situated on the Main Road to Somo Ferry thence down the said road to the first crop fence thence along the said crop fence to the waste thence along the waste fence to the public Road thence down the said public road to the fork named Station (the school house) thence and to the said down land with every part and parcel thereof with all the tenements and singular the premises before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of her right like interest and claim to her heirs and assigns unto the said Merch. S. Davis his heirs and assigns during my life only to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Merch. S. Davis his heirs and assigns during my life only. And the said Elizabeth A. Harrison Widow of Wm. H. Harrison did for herself her heirs the said dower land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Merch. S. Davis his heirs and assigns during my life only free from the claims or claims of her the said Elizabeth A. Harrison Widow of Wm. H.
