payments of which we had ourselves our heirs ours & assigns jointly and severally
firmly by these presents Witness our hands and seals the 19th day of January 1847
thousand eight hundred and forty seven

The Conditions of the above obligation is such that Whereas Drury Pymont
Benjamin Pymont and Francis Pymont being entitled each to one sixth of the
estate of Elizabeth Porter in the hands of Wm S Pymont her Curator and whereas
the said Drury Pymont and Francis Pymont have been absent from the Commonwealth
of Virginia for many years & have not been heard from & Whereas in the month
of this month without heirs the said Hindrott in right of his wife Lucy M formerly
Barrett is entitled to one fourth of their respective shares of said Porter's estate
and whereas the above named Henry Hindrott has this day received of the said
William S. Pymont Curator of Elizabeth Porter dec^d the sum of \$38.25.07
as supposed his of Drury Benjamin and Francis Pymont now if the said
Francis Pymont and Drury Pymont or either of them or their legal heirs and

This Indenture made and entered into the 1st day of December 1846 between
Robert Ritchey and Anne & his wife of the one part and the heirs of Joseph
Nichols of the other part Whereas Joseph Nichols by A. B. Buile his Attorney
in the year 1843 by deed bearing date day of 1843 of Record in
the Clerk's Office of Southampton County conveyed to the said Ritchey a certain
tract of Land containing 172 acres more or less lying in the County of Southampton
being the said tract by the said Joseph Nichols from his Father Nick Nichols
and whereas by agreement at the time of the execution of the said deed
William Buile conveyed his lands to the said A. B. Buile Attorney as aforesaid
for the purchase of the said Land in the stead of the said Ritchey and Whereas
it is now ascertained that at the time the said deed was executed by the said
