

Nicholson by his agent in the said Ridley the said Nicholson was a minor and incapable in Law of executing a deed and that he died before attaining full age, thereby rendering it impossible to make a valid deed Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of \$430 paid by delivering the lands above mentioned of William Parker to wit, one tract for \$230 due one year after date and four tracts for \$100 each due one three four & five years after date bearing date 27th July 1843 to the said Ridley he and his wife hereby give grant and release to the said Joseph Nicholson and his heirs all right title and claim which they may have to the above mentioned tract of Land by virtue of the said Deed from Joseph Nicholson by A C Paine his attorney in fact to hold the same free from the claims of the said Ridley and of his wife their heirs and assigns the testimony whereof the said Ridley's wife hereunto set their hands and seals the date first above written

Williams the receipt, Well and whereof is hereby acknowledged she the said Rebecca Briggs hath granted let sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Edwin R. Williams his heirs and assigns a certain tract of Land lying and being in the County of Paulthampten containing by estimation four hundred and fifty eight acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Robert, Nicholas Thomas S. Pringle Elizabeth S. Williams Joseph Poper Elizabeth Kelso and John Davis wife the said Edwin R. Williams his heirs and assigns forever to have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Edwin R. Williams his heirs and assigns forever and the said Rebecca Briggs for herself and her heirs and
