party, witnesseth that the said John H. Brack and Dorothy his wife and Sam'l Helle
for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars current Money to them in
hand paid by the said John Hines at and before the sealing and delivery of
these presents the Receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they have granted
bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto theforesaid
emory and confirm unto the said John Hines his heirs and assigns all that certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County which is the property
now cut off from the lands purchased from Lewis N. Branch, trusted and received
by the said John H. Brack in the name of lands with Henry Brack and is situated
in the fork of the Colham and Whig Roads, and containing five acres more or less
30 hours and so to hold the said heretofore tract or parcel of land and premises
with the appurtenances unto the estate right title interest, claim and demand what
