This Indenture made and entered into this 15<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord God thousand eight hundred and forty seven between Miles Worrell and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and the State of Virginia of the one part and Harrison P Popo of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Miles Worrell and Mary Worrell for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty four dollars to them in hand paid by the said Harrison P Popo at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said Harrison P Popo his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing seventy five acres by the same more or less adjoining the lands of Colonel Popo east and North side and the lands of Parake Popo on the North west, west and South side together with all the right title interest claim or demand of us and to the said associated tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Harrison P Popo his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Harrison P Popo his heirs and assigns forever And the said Miles Worrell and his wife Mary Worrell for themselves their heirs executors and administrators doth hereby severally and agreed to and with the said Harrison P Popo his heirs executors administrators and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
