This instrument made and entered into the 15th day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty seven between Joseph P. Powell and Mary Jane his wife of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one party and Mike Worrill of the same county and State of the other party, witnesseth that the said Joseph P. Powell and Mary Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars current money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Mike Worrill at and before the sealing and delivery of this present do and make of their dark grained leather and sell unto him the said Mike Worrill his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke containing by survey three hundred and seven acres in the same more or less it being said Mary Jane portion of the land drawn by herself and Joseph P. Powell in the division of the lands of Lewis Worrill and which has since been divided between them and bounded by the lands of Thomas Dawson Lewis Wicks and others together with all rights, liberties, inheritances, claims or demands of me and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto belonging or in any wise appertaining. I do hereby and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereunto belonging as aforesaid unto him the said Mike Worrill his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose now and before of him the said Mike Worrill his heirs and assigns forever unto the said Joseph P. Powell and Mary Jane his wife for themselves their heirs, executors and administrators of them dark grained leather and agreed to and with the said Mike Worrill his heirs executors administrators and assigns that they will by their present warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever the witness whereof the said Joseph P. Powell and Mary Jane his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seal the day and year first above written
