and Emeline his wife (formerly Emeline Story) all of Bond County State of Missouri
of the one part, and Charles Roundtree of the County of Southampton State of
Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Levi W. Story George N.
Whifield and Emeline his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
dollars current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid by
the said Charles Roundtree at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold
and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto
him the said Charles Roundtree his heirs and assigns forever all their right title
whereby claim or demand of his and to the undivided tenth or parcel of land and
premises of which James Story Grandfather of said Levi W. Story and Emeline
Whifield (deceased) did properly situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of
Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke containing one hundred
and four acres to the same now left and bounded by the Land of William
Vick Sam Ruth Polly Story and others and through which the Rail Road
passes so far as to hold all the right title interest claim or demand of
said the said Levi W. Story George N. Whifield & Emeline his wife of us and to the
above described tract or parcel of land and premises unto him the said Charles Round-
tree his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose as and behove of him
the said Charles Roundtree his heirs and assigns forever and the said Levi W. Story
George N. Whifield and Emeline his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators
do and each of them doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Charles
Roundtree his heirs executors and assigns that they will by due process warrant
and forever defend all the aforesaid rights title interest claim or demand of and in
to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises against the claim or demand
of all and every other person or persons whatsoever it may whereof the said
Levi W. Story George N. Whifield and Emeline his wife have herunto set their hands
and affixed their seals the day and year first above written
