Perry examined by the Court as oath to be the identical persons whose names are subscribed to the foregoing instrument of writing as having executed the same and severally acknowledged the same to be their act and deed for the purpose therein mentioned that the said Emeline being first made acquainted with the contents of said instrument and examined separately and apart from her husband whether she executed the said deed voluntarily freely and without the compulsion or undue influence of her said husband acknowledged and declared that she had executed the said deed voluntarily freely and without compulsion or under influence of her said husband and did not wish to retract it. Clout of the one part and John Drury of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph W. Clout in consideration of two hundred and twenty eight dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said John Drury at or before the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Drury his heirs and assigns all of his proprietary interest in a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton being the lower end of the tract of land which the late John Holt died seized and possessed of which is now in the possession of Nancy Holt to be held by her during her natural life or widowhood and bounded as follows beginning at a pine tree on the North West side of the Road near opposite the upper post, at the fork of the road leading from the Stranahan Road to the 4 legs running a line of Marked, 1846
