This Indenture made this 12th day of February 1847 between James Griffin of the County of Southampton and State of Va. of the one part and James McElmery of the aforesaid County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said James Griffin in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars lawful Money of Va. to him in hand paid by the said James McElmery at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said James McElmery his heirs and assigns a certain tract of Land together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging situated and lying in the County aforesaid and being the same wherein the said James Griffin now lives containing forty seven and a half acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) by the Land of Sir John Charles (formerly) now James McElmery & by the Land of Thomas Soper S.E. by the Land of Holly Drake & by the Lands of Thomas Pickett and Martha S. Barber's W & S to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said James McElmery his heirs and assigns to him and his iud and behoof forever and the said James Griffin for himself and his heirs warrant the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said James McElmery his heirs and assigns forever from the claims of him the said James Griffin his heirs and all and every person whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
