

Agreement entered into this 13th day of December A.D. 1848 between Margaret P. Barrett, Benjamin P. Barrett, William P. Barrett and James S. Darden & Catharine & his wife legatees under the last Will of Capt. John Barrett deceased and all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas by the last Will of said John Barrett deceased among other legatees his will left all his Lands (subject to the widow above) to his two sons George P. and William P. Barrett aforesaid leaving to his daughter Catharine & her late husband with James S. Darden's fifteen hundred dollars to make her equal with his two brothers as to their lands said sum to be paid out of his estate and in the event that either of his said children should die leaving no lawful issue such child's portion to go to the survivor or survivors. And whereas upon the settlement of said John Barrett's estate there seems to be no surplus left in the hands of the Representatives out of which to pay the said legacy of fifteen hundred dollars and no convenient sum thereof it is agreed that the said George P. & William P. Barrett are legally bound to contribute equally to the said Catharine & in order to make her equal to them in land under the Will aforesaid which it seems they are unable to do without sacrificing their property and whereas Margaret P. Barrett aforesaid Mother of said legatees being willing and desirous to arrange and settle the difference between her said children to the mutual satisfaction of them all and to which end she said legatees have this day met together at the house of their said Mother all of whom being desirous to settle the matter in difference aforesaid now in order that unto the parties do much for himself covenant to and with the other to comply with the conditions & stipulations following to wit:

Article 1st The said Margaret P. Barrett agrees to pay to James S. Darden and his wife Catharine & the sum of eight hundred and twenty dollars in full and in consideration for the said legacy of fifteen hundred dollars as bequeathed by the Will of said John P. Barrett deceased and in consideration of which the said James S. Darden and his wife Catharine & hereby agree and bind themselves to release discharge and acquit the said Margaret P. Barrett George P. & William P. Barretts from the payment of any part of said legacy of fifteen hundred dollars as bequeathed to said Catharine & by the Will of John P. Barrett deceased aforesaid and to forever discharge them as well as the residue of said John P. Barrett deceased from all liability now and forever on account of said legacy and they the said James S. Darden and his wife Catharine & do and will by these presents forever acknowledge and remunerate fully satisfied.

Article 2nd The said George P. & William P. Barrett do each for himself hereby agree that the said sum of eight hundred and twenty five dollars this day paid by the said Margaret P. Barrett to James S. Darden and Catharine & his wife be received by them in full simple and is to be in the said subject to or controlled by the clause or clauses in the Will of said John P. Barrett deceased which directs that in case that either of his said children shall die without lawful issue such child's portion to go to the survivor or survivors they the said George P. & William P. Barrett claiming no right under the said clause in the event of the death of said Catharine & without just cause. Whereas the said parties have made out their hands and affixed their seals.
