

This Indenture made this thirtieth day of February one thousand eight hundred and forty seven between Elizabeth E. Post of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part, and Joshua Bryant of the County and State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid by him the said Joshua Bryant unto the said Elizabeth E. Post the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto him the said Joshua Bryant his heirs executors or administrators one certain tract of Land lying on the south west side of the Road leading from Monroe to Rock Water bridge bounded by James W. & Kapenburo's line on the south west the heirs of Schabaz Coleman on the south and the heirs of William Deal down on the east containing by estimation one hundred acres more or less with the houses and all privileges thereto belonging unto him the said Joshua Bryant his heirs executors and administrators the right and title of which said Land the said Elizabeth E. Post binds herself her heirs executors and administrators to defend unto him the said Joshua Bryant his heirs executors and administrators forever against the claim or claims of all persons whatever, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and date above written

Cobb of the County of Stafford and State of North Carolina of the first part, and Jesse Cobb of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Frederick H. Cobb for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Cobb at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Frederick H. Cobb do hereby confess and acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Cobb his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia and adjoining the Lands of Matthew W. Vaughan's Heirs and Father and William Cobb and and James Vaughan and containing sixty acres more or less together with the meadows and meadows remainder and remainders yearly and other unto the issue and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular the premises before mentioned or intimated or granted bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Jesse Cobb his heirs and assigns forever To have for the only proper use and behoof
