This Indenture made and entered into on this day of March year 1847 by and between John Vick and Mary Mariza his wife of the one part and Josiah Vick of the other party each party of the county of Southampton in the State of Virginia. This Indenture Witnesseth that they the said John Vick and Mary his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of forty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Josiah Vick at the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said John Vick and Mary his wife and in consideration of which they the said John Vick and Mary his wife have bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto him the said Josiah Vick a certain portion of Land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke containing seven and one fourth acres by a late survey the said portion of Land being a part of the Lands of which James Vick died seized and possessed from whose death he the said John Vick derives his title and as to this particular portion of Land above named he the said John Vick derives special title by a deed in writing recorded to him by the several heirs of the said James Vick died which deed is of Record in the Clerk's Office of the aforesaid County of Southampton further move they the said John Vick and Mary Mariza Vick his wife have for and in consideration of the further sum of fifteen dollars to them in hand paid by the said Josiah Vick at the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is also acknowledged have hereby further bargained and sold and do by these presents do and each of them do hereby grant bargain and sell unto him the said Josiah Vick his heirs and assigns all their further right title interest and estate whatever in and to the Lands of which he the said James Vick died seized and possessed say that portion of said decedent's Lands which is now in the possession of Lydia Vick Widow and relict of the said James Vick died so have and to hold the above described portion of seven and one fourth acres of Land also the right title interest and estate which they the said John Vick and Mary Mariza his wife have heretofore held in and the Lands now in the possession of the above named Lydia Vick in Law of course in her husband's hands to him the said Josiah Vick and his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him
