This Indenture Made and entered into on this 13th day of March in the year 1847 by and between James Vick and Julia Ann Vick his wife of the one part and Josiah Vick of the other part each party of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia This Indenture Witnesseth that they the said James Vick and Julia Ann his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty three dollars to them in hand paid by Josiah Vick at the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said James Vick and Julia Ann his wife and in consideration of which they the said James Vick and Julia Ann his wife have bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto him the said Josiah Vick a certain portion of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton in the parish of Saint Luke containing twenty five and one fourth acre by a late survey the said lands being apart of the lands of which James Vick direct seized and possessed by whose death he the said James Vick derived his title and as to the particular portion of Land hereby conveyed he the said James Vick claimed special to the
