his heirs and assigns free from the claims of him the said William A Spark
or his heirs and of all and every person or persons claiming by thought or
under him shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents

the said J B. R. A. C. J. & A B Urquhart do by these presents warrant
and forever defend the right and title of the said Lots and improvements unto
him the said William D Clarke his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims
or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof
