The condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas the above bound James Holmes was on the 19th day of April 1847 by the school Commissioners in and for the County of Southampton appointed their Treasurer for the year ending on the 31st day of December 1847 Now if the said James Holmes shall faithfully apply and account for all moneys which may come to his hands by virtue of his Office and shall so perform and execute all and every act and thing appertaining to his said Office according to Law then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
