Briddle of the other party witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to Ervin Griffin Commissioner or of the aforesaid Walter G. Briddle in hand paid or received to be paid by the said Mary W. Briddle at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Ervin Griffin as Commissioner have bargained and sold released and confirmed and by these presents do bargain and sell release and confirm unto her the said Mary G. Briddle her heirs and assigns forever all the right title and interest which to the said Ervin Griffin as Commissioner has to that tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances situated lying and being in the County of Southampton bounded by the lands of Ruth Mutual White, James Uryghart, R. A. Uryghart, Asa Uryghart, Charles C. Uryghart and others and containing five hundred and fifty acres by the said Mary or A. P. 150 acres to have and to hold the said parcel of land with the boundaries aforesaid and all and singular other premises heretofore bounded or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel there of unto the said Mary W. Briddle her heirs and assigns forever and the said Ervin Griffin Commissioner for himself and his heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said
