thousand eight hundred and forty seven between Bennett Pader of this our
part and John Crumpler of the other part both of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia. Wittenby that for and in Consideration of the sum
of Thirty dollars to him or hand paid or otherwise secured before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by
the said Bennett Pader have granted Bargained and sold and do by these
presents grant Bargain sell enfor and Confer unto the said John Crumpler
and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right title claim and interest in
or to the lands and plantations wherewith my Father John Pader had
and said Land lying in the County of Southampton and immediately on the
Doctor Road and bounded as follows (to wit) by the Lands of George L. Drew
the Lands belonging to the heirs of George V. Collement also and the Lands of
the said John Crumpler. To have and to hold the said interest in the said
parcel of land to the said John Crumpler and to his heirs and assigns to
their proper use and behoof forever and to the said Bennett Pader or further
covenant to and with the said John Crumpler that this present deed of Bargain
and sale shall be unto him the said John Crumpler and to his heirs and assigns
