Thus Indenture made the 19 day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty seven between Bennett Padler of the one part and John Crumpler of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars to him or her paid or otherwise secured before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Bennett Padler have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said John Crumpler and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right title claim and interest in or to the land and plantations whereon my Father John P. Padler lived and died said Land lying in the County of Southampton and immediately on the River Road and bounded as follows (to wit) by the Lands of Perry & Dru the Lands belonging to the heirs of George W. Hollman and the Lands of the said John Crumpler. To have and to hold the said interest in the said parcel of land to the said John Crumpler and to his heirs and assigns to their proper use and behoof forever and the said Bennett Padler do further covenant to and with the said John Crumpler that this present deed of bargain and sale shall be unto him the said John Crumpler and to his heirs and assigns forever a good and sufficient warranty against him the said Bennett Padler his heirs and assigns as well as against the right title claim and demand of all and every other person or persons claiming by through or under him the Witness whereof the said Bennett Padler has hereunto set his hand and seal the day and date first above written signed sealed and delivered
