Cobb of the County of Dallas and State of Alabama of the other part Witnesseth the said Jeremiah Cobb and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five hundred dollars in hand paid by the said Benjamin C. Cobb the Receipt whereof the said Jeremiah Cobb and Elizabeth his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and justly have granted bargained and sold shewed conveyed and confirmed and by these presents have granted bargained and sold shewed conveyed and confirmed unto the said Benjamin C. Cobb to him and to his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises containing about six hundred acres being the same more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid it being the tract of Land on which I live including the tract I bought of William Bell Charles Drury and Benj<sup>r</sup> Drury's estate well understood a divided of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for the aforesaid County of Southampton and being as follows to wit on the west by the aforesaid swamp on the south the lands belonging to the heirs of William Bell on the east by O'Brien Mill swamp and Mill pond and Indian branch and on the North by Louis Sumners and S. B. all land together with all houses buildings yards gardens and orchards ways water and Water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of Land. To have and to hold the same unto the said Benjamin Cobb to him and to his heirs forever with the said Jeremiah Cobb and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns doth by these presents Covenant and grant to and with the said Benjamin C. Cobb his heirs and assigns that they will by their persons servants and defend all right title claim or demand of any person persons claiming or demanding the same at any part or parcel thereof the Witness whereof the said Jeremiah Cobb and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day and year first above written
